- Feel free to bring your dog along

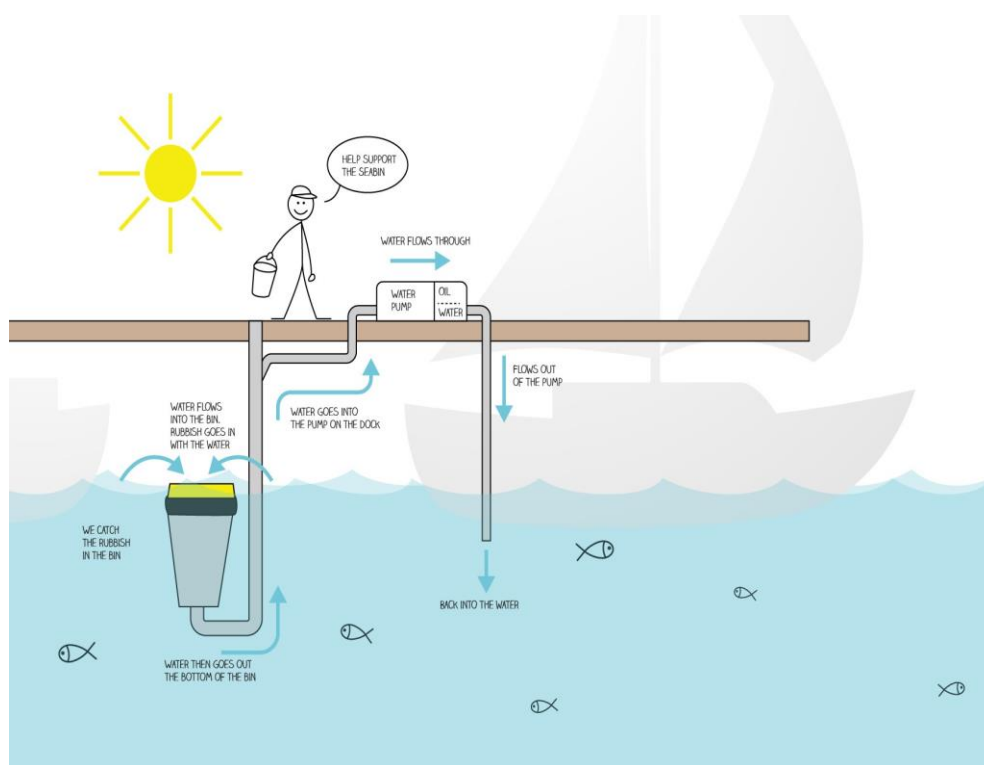
If you don't want to walk you can volunteer to run a water-stop or pick up full rubbish bags in your car.

What is a Seabin, and why do we want one anyway?
